

IDEA 1: CREATE A MASKING TAPE DOT GUIDE

1. Cut out the template along the crop marks. A blank template has been included on Page 2. (-:
2. Poke a hole through each of the small, black dots on the template. You will use these to make light guide marks.
3. Before making guide marks, secure the template to your page so it doesn't move around while you place your marks.
4. Use a mechanical pencil to make a light mark through each of the dots onto your page. These will show you where to place your masking tape.

IDEA 2: CREATE A STENCIL GUIDE

1. Cut out the template below along crop marks.
2. Cut out each of the six rectangles.
3. Before making guide lines, secure the template to your page so it doesn't move around while you place your marks.
4. Use a pencil to lightly (or darkly!) draw the six rectangles on the template. These will be where you can paint your skies!

IDEA 1

Poke a hole through each black dot, then use a mechanical pencil to make light marks on your page. This will create a dot guide showing where to place your masking tape. This way, you don't need to mask the full page all at once.

If you don't want to make a dot guide, try cutting out each sky section (the blue rectangles) and use these as a stencil guide for your skies!
